Applications Invited for Annual IWSA Awards : 2018-19

1. **“LIC Award”**: This award is instituted by L.I.C. of India for bright girl students from science stream who are studying in XI Std during 2018-2019.

Eligibility: Students with 60% marks or above in X std. exams and with an annual family income not exceeding Rs. 3 lakhs are eligible to apply.

2. **Mrs. Tara Pandit and Dr. Satyendrarao Pandit Award**: This award is instituted by Dr. Lalitha Dhareshwar in the name of her parents for a challenged girl student who has stood First in X Std. exam from Maharashtra SSC Board, in 2018 from a Navi Mumbai School.
3. **Mrs Leela Bansiya Award”**: This award is instituted by Mr. Jagdish Bansiya in the name of his mother. It is for the bright young girl student who has stood first in the HSC Exam in 2018 from a Navi Mumbai School.

4. **Dr. Shantoo Gurnani “Merit-cum-Means" Award**: For girl students at the graduate levels --science stream only.

Eligibility: Girls pursuing B.Sc. in any science stream (from first to third year). Students with family income of less than Rs 3.00 lakhs/ annum can apply.

5. **Chetan Premani Memorial Award** – For girl students at the post graduate level – Science Stream only

Eligibility: Girls pursuing M.Sc. in any science stream. Students with annual family income less than Rs. 4 lakhs are eligible to apply.

- * 6. **“Late Dr. Jayshree Daoo Award”**: This award is instituted by Major Vikrant Daoo in memory of his mother. It is for a bright young girl pursuing Ph.D. in the field of Science.

Eligibility: Students in their second year of their Ph.D. program are eligible. They should submit the research proposal given for Ph.D. registration. Students with annual family income less than Rs. 4 lakhs are eligible to apply.

- *7. **“Late Dr. Sumati and Mr. Vasudeo Bhide Award”** This award is instituted by Prof. Amar Bhide in the memory of his parents. It is for a bright young girl pursuing Ph.D. in the field of Science.

Eligibility: Students in their second year of their Ph.D. program are eligible. They should submit research proposal given for Ph.D. registration. Students with annual family income less than Rs. 4 lakhs are eligible to apply.

- *8. **“Dr. Suresh K. Mahajan Memorial Scholarship”**: This Scholarship has been instituted at IWSA, 2016, by Dr. Suresh Mahajan's student, Dr. V. Sanzgiri.

Eligibility: The scholarship will be given to a bright girl student pursuing a Ph.D. in any discipline of life Sciences and in the second year of the PhD program. Students with annual family income less than Rs. 4 lakhs are eligible to apply.

This Scholarship of Rs. 50,000/ will also carry a citation and a trophy. The applicants must provide their research proposal submitted for Ph.D. registration.

In addition, there are several other awards instituted by generous donors, well wishers and IWSA members. These are for students attending different courses in IWSA.
