MAJOR ACTIVITIES at Head Quarters (HQ) and Branches (Br)

- **Popularization of Science:** Seminars, workshops, refresher courses, lectures, exhibitions, and learning science through activities are regular features, with experiments being conducted in science laboratories (HQ & Br).
- **Computer Training Course:** IWSA conducts need based programs for teachers, students, Sr. citizens, housewives and businessmen (only at HQ).
- **Science Library:** Library is equipped with popular science books, magazines & journals in different languages (only at HQ).
- **Early Childhood Care and Education Diploma Course for Nursery/Creche Teachers' Training:** This course of IWSA is affiliated to SNDT Women's University, Mumbai (only at HQ).

CONFERENCES

National and International conferences are organized by IWSA at regular intervals. The themes of these conferences normally emphasize women, their involvement in S & T, and the issues therein. These meetings also bring women scientists and other members together on a common platform. (Organized by HQ & Branches)

COMMUNITY WELFARE ACTIVITIES (at Head Quarters)

- **Health Care Centre:** A dentist, physiotherapist and clinician on call are available for consultations. Lectures and health camps on varied health topics are regular features.
- **Working Women's Hostel:** IWSA provides accommodation to about 160 working women/students.
- **Day Care Centre:** IWSA provides day care facilities under trained supervision.
- **Nursery School:** IWSA conducts a nursery school with trained staff.
- **Scholarships and Awards:** Merit-cum-means scholarships/awards are given annually to girl students pursuing science studies.
